The chosen example supports unit 12 (Dragon Scales) of the QCA scheme, which concerns pentatonic music.

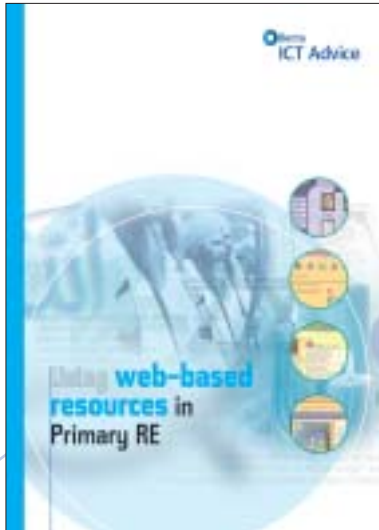

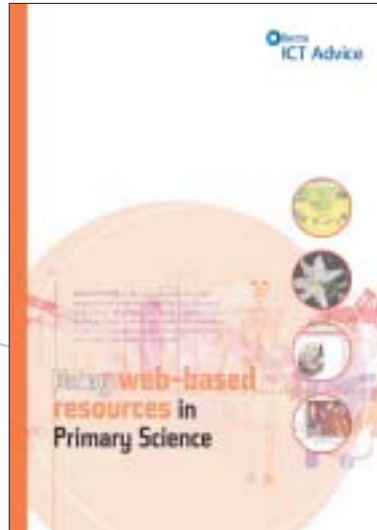

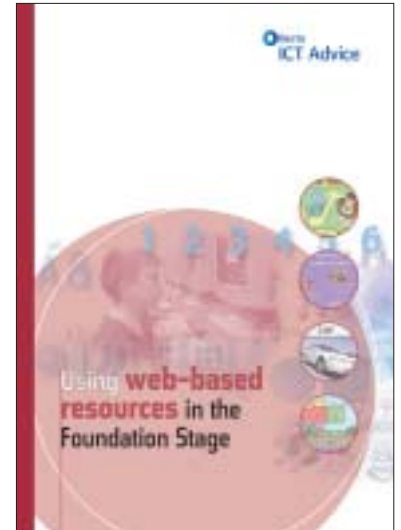
